The W3+ Fair Rhine Valley 2022 expands

For the third time, the W3+ Fair Rhine Valley calls developers, suppliers and users of enabling technologies around optics, photonics, electronics and mechanics to the Rhine Valley. At the high-tech event, experts can exchange ideas in person and jointly launch forward-looking innovations. More extensive networking is promised by two parallel events: Thanks to the TECH.CON trade fair and the photonics conference of the University of Applied Sciences Eastern Switzerland, Dornbirn will become a high-tech hub in the four-country region at the end of November.

On November 30 - December 01, 2022, this year's W3+ Fair Rhine Valley (w3-fair.com) with the free accompanying conference en-tech.talks will take place in the Dornbirn Exhibition Center. Even more inspiration awaits exhibitors and visitors, as two additional events take advantage of the fair's high-quality high-tech environment: TECH.CON, the platform for industry, commerce and production companies in the Lake Constance region, will be held simultaneously in the adjacent hall. Top-class expertise will be brought along by the University of Applied Sciences of Eastern Switzerland, which is docking its established high-tech conference "Precision Photonic Systems" to the W3+ Fair for the first time. This makes Dornbirn an information and networking hotspot in the four-country region - one of the top ten high-tech locations in Europe!

Major companies such as Swarovski, SwissOptic, OptoTech, WZW Optic, APM Technica, the University of Applied Sciences Graubünden, Eplan, Acktar, RhySearch, Laservision, FPM Holding, Victor Kyburz, Chroma Technology, OPC, Polytec, Sensofar and others have already confirmed their participation as exhibitors at the W3+ Fair. The number of partners is also growing. In addition to EPIC, Swissphotonics, Photonics Austria, OptecNet Deutschland, Wetzlar Network, Biolago, IVAM, Spectaris, and Hessen Trade & Invest, the IV Industriellenvereinigung Vorarlberg will be present for the first time, guaranteeing strong regional attention. A central component of the trade show will again be the accompanying conference en-tech.talks with the EPIC TechWatch, which offers best knowledge transfer on topics such as optics manufacturing, business opportunities and Industry 4.0.
